- 4. In accordance with the 2019 Policy Direction,<sup>3</sup> the Commission considers that this order, which is based on a complete record, can promote competition, affordability, consumer interests, and innovation. Specifically, the final approval of these applications will promote (i) consumer interests, because it will increase competition in the identified provinces; and (ii) innovation, because it will ensure that consumers have access to high-quality telecommunications services.
- 5. Revised tariff pages are to be issued within 10 calendar days of the date of this order. Revised tariff pages can be submitted to the Commission without a description page or a request for approval; a tariff application is not required.
